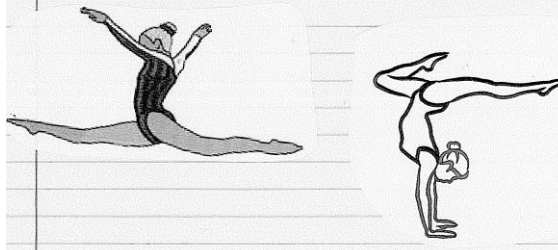

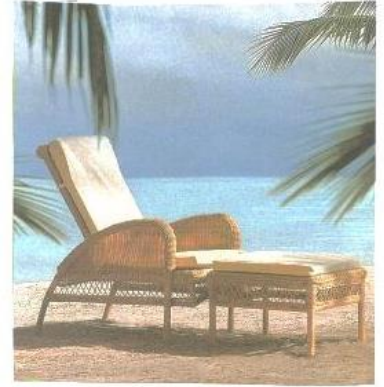

Oporto Cathedral

The Oporto Cathedral is a catholic church located in the historical center of Oporto city and one of the most popular attractions in Oporto area.

The beginning of its construction was in the XII century, which made this Cathedral one of the oldest monuments of Portugal. Over the centuries it has had several interventions, which can be identified by the various architectural styles, for instance Gothic, Romanesque and Baroque.

Most people go there nowadays because it is one of the starting points for the Santiago paths. If you want to see the Cathedral you do not have to pay anything unless you want to visit the cloister which I definitely recommend. The cloister belongs to the XIV century and is decorated with tiles reflecting religious scenes. From the Cloister you can also enter the "Casa do Cabido", where is displayed a collection of religious jewelry.

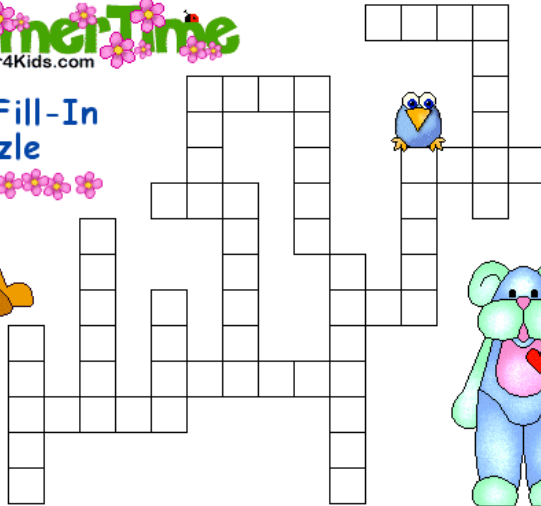

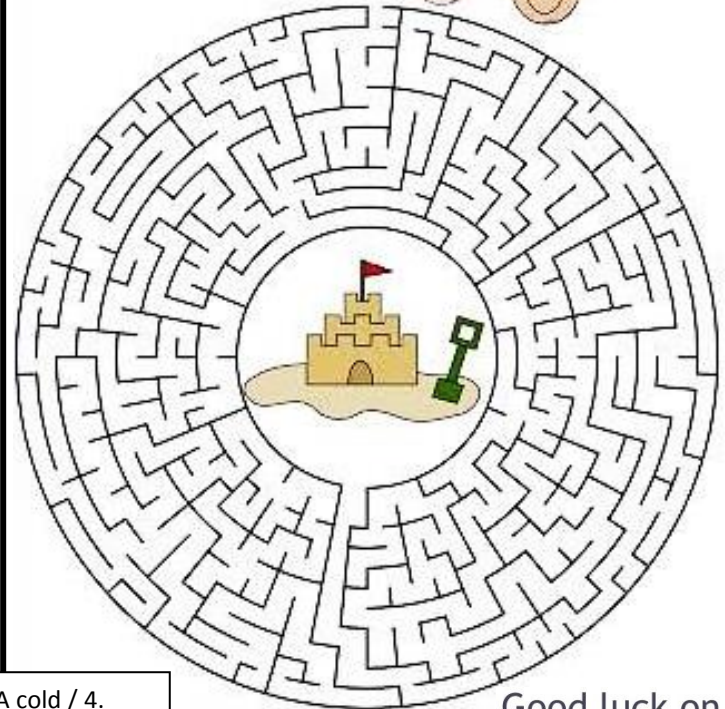
