All the teachers at the Institute wish you and your families a **WONDERFUL 2019!!!** We hope you had a great Christmas (and that you got the presents you wished for 😊)

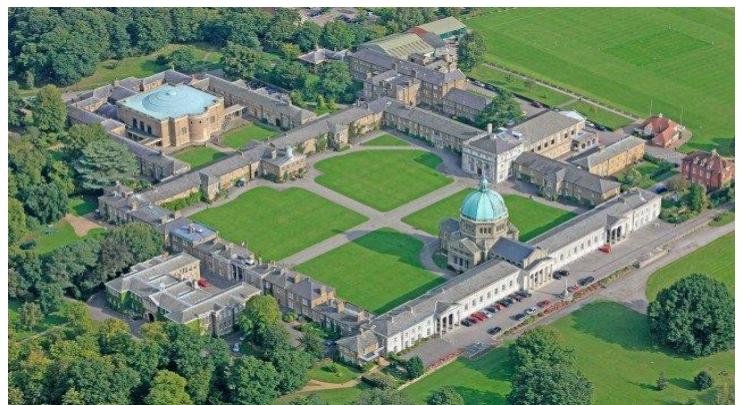
We also hope that the New Year brings you all lots of joy, happiness, love and health.

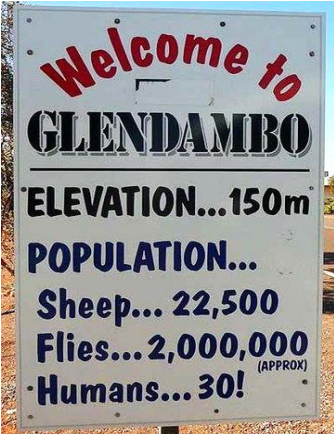
Fun Facts

26th January is Australia Day. Two of your teachers are from Australia. Australia is a HUGE country on the other side of the world. Here are some interesting facts about Australia:

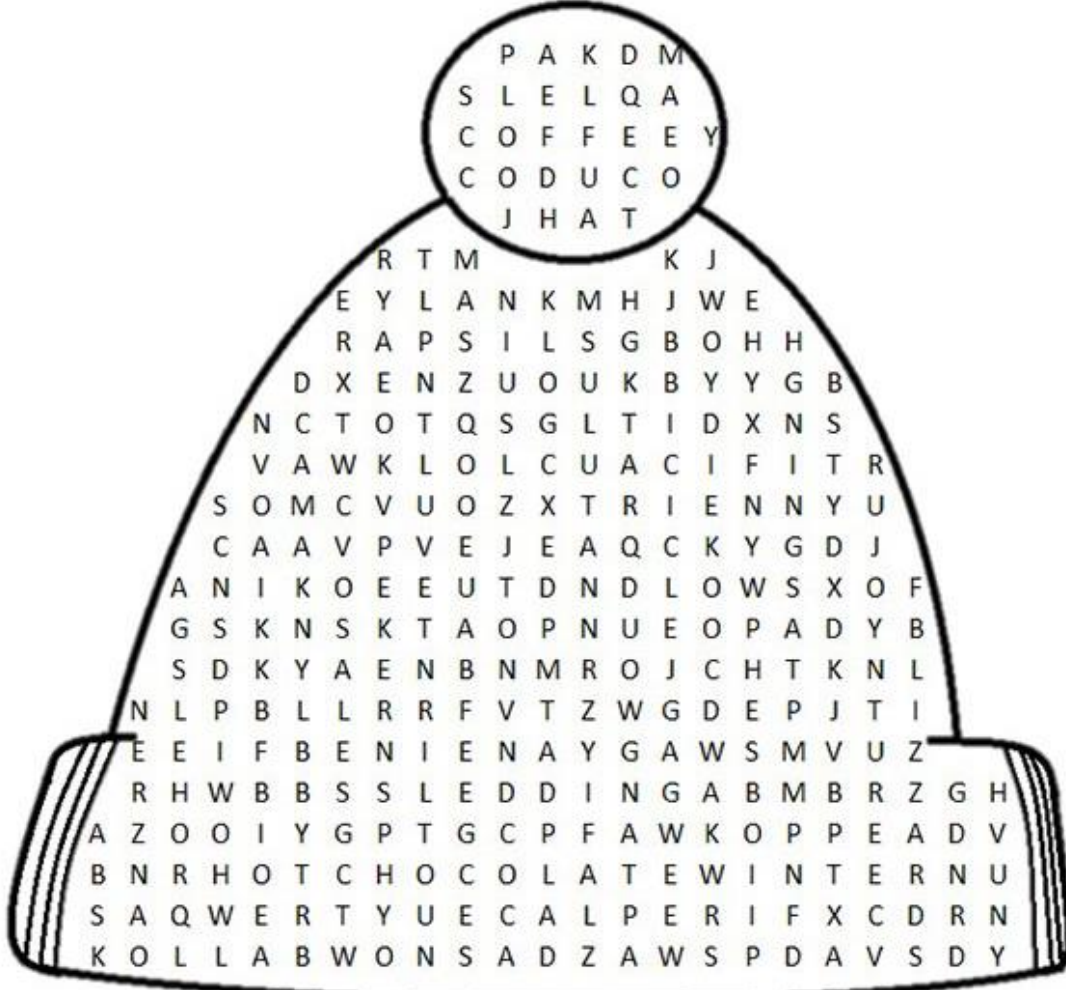


- It is commonly known as “The land down under”.

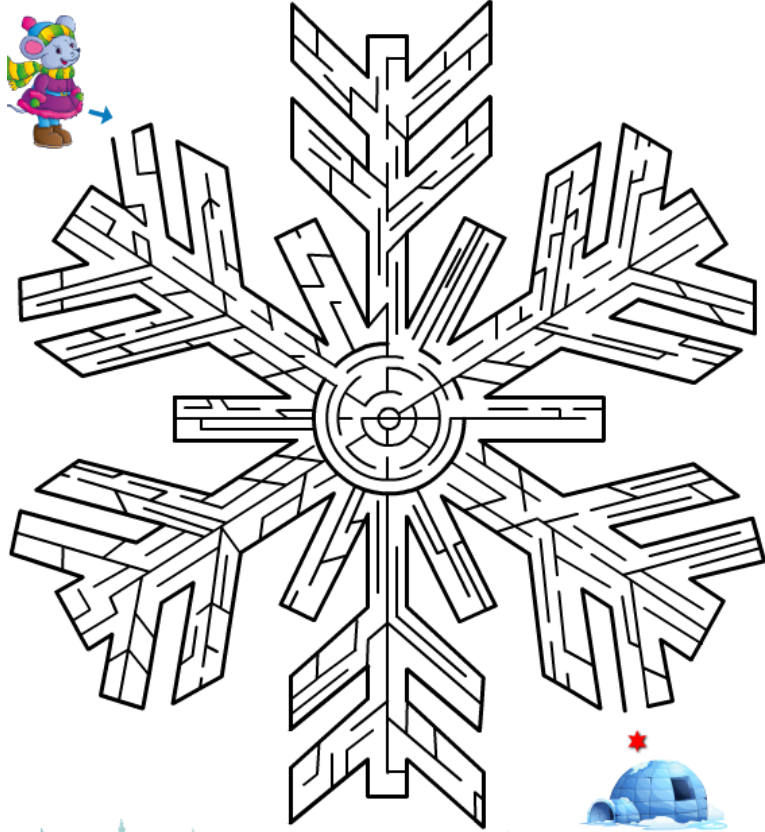

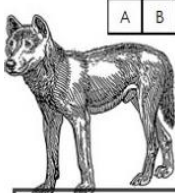
